



Applying for the 2009 ESICM ECCRN & Industry Research Awards.

Applications are for ESICM members only who have paid their 2009 membership fees. If you are not a member we ask you to apply for membership either directly through our membership page or via the Awards application site (after you have filled in step 2). Membership application can take up to 6 weeks to process, so if you have not received your membership ID when you are submitting your application please contact Elise Maquestiaux (research@esicm.org).

You will need to prepare the following:

- A project title
- Choose up to 3 awards you wish to apply for (see www.esicm.org for full details of each award)
- Your ESICM member ID code
- Your mentor/supervisor's name and contact details
- The host institution details (where you will be performing the research) along with the research director's name
- An brief outline of any potential competing interests you may have
- The number of ICUs, research institutes and patients, as well as the countries involved
- A short project summary, as well as project start date & duration (max. ½ page, without any graphics or tables)
- A longer project summary (including graphics + tables if desired)
- Resources available for the project (personnel, equipment, etc) from within the research institute which are not being financed by the award (should it be granted)
- Your project's budget (please use the budget template provided, see www.esicm.org)
- Your CV (in word or pdf format)
- Letters of recommendation from your mentor/supervisor and research director (word or pdf format) (optional)
- Your letter of motivation (ie a brief outline as to why you want to apply for awards)
- A picture of yourself (jpg, gif or png format)
- Please note that it **not possible to import Office 2007 format** (i.e. .docx or .xlsx)

Once you have started the application process, you will receive an email which will enable you to access your application and to go back to add documents, make modifications and move forward to the next steps. Please remember that when you validate your application in the final step, you will no longer be able to make any further modifications.

Applications will open 1st February 2009. Applications must be submitted online via the link provided on the ECCRN awards page.

Neither the ESICM nor the industrial partner that supports the Award (when applicable) may claim intellectual property of the results. In case my application is rewarded by an Industry Research Award, I agree to disclose the main findings of the study to the Company before any publication of the results.
- With the acceptance of the Award, I commit to attend the Opening Ceremony of the ESICM Annual Congress for presentation of the prize. I also agree to submit an abstract of the results of the study for presentation at the ESICM Congress within one year after completion of the study, and to submit an administrative end-of-project report in English within 3 months of the end of the project. I understand that submission for publication of the final results to Intensive Care Medicine is strongly encouraged, but not mandatory.
