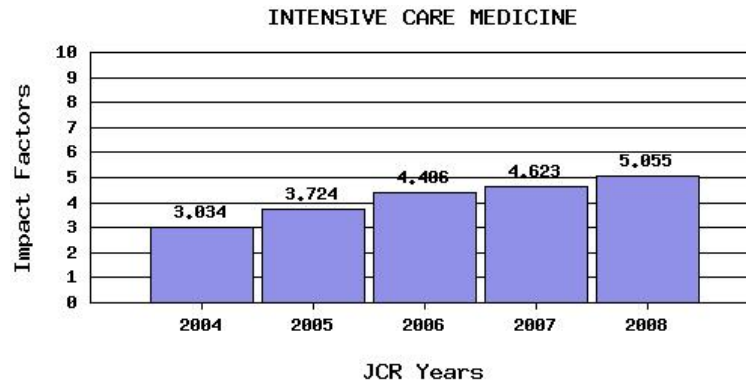




Impact Factor Trend Graph: INTENSIVE CARE MEDICINE

**Impact Factor -- see below for calculations*

The journal impact factor is a measure of the frequency with which the "average article" in a journal has been cited in a particular year. The impact factor will help you evaluate a journal's relative importance, especially when you compare it to others in the same field. NOTE: Title changes and coverage changes may result in no impact factor for one or more years in the above graph.

Calculation: $\frac{\text{Cites to recent articles}}{\text{Number of recent articles}} = \frac{2553}{505} = 5.055$
