

Translation and validity of the EDIC certificate

The ESICM delivers a Diploma in Intensive Care for those who have passed the EDIC Part I and II, and as such fulfill criteria for receiving the Diploma. This Diploma is in English only. The ESICM will not take on the responsibility to translate and/or proceed for national validation of this diploma in any way. It is up to the candidate to get information about how to use this Diploma in her/his own country.

Example: Saudi Arabia (Saudi Arabia embassy in Brussels)

The following procedure must be followed in Belgium to make your certificate valid in Saudi Arabia (done in approximatively 5 days)

1. Certificate needs to be translated into Arabic language (must be done in Belgium)
2. Certificate needs to go through the County Court (Tribunal de 1er instance; Palais de Justice; Place Poelaert 1; B-1000 Bruxelles Phone 32.2/508.61.11; Fax 32.2/508.68.01)
3. Ministry of Justice to legalize the translation and the signature of the County Court (Rue des Petits Carmes, 27; B-1000 Bruxelles; Phone. 32.2.501.87.85; Fax. 32.2.501.89.00)
4. Foreign Affairs Ministry to legalize the two other signatures (Rue des Petits Carmes, 15; B-1000 Bruxelles; Phone 32.2.501.81.11)
5. Saudi Arabia Consulate to validate your diploma legalized from Belgium for use in your country
