Working group	<p>Members from the HRSO, NIC and POIC section initiated a new cross sectional working group about Delirium and Long Term Outcome (DeLTO). The first meeting was during LIVES 2018 and Arjen Slooter (Utrecht) was elected chair of the DeLTO working group. All interested ESICM members are invited to attend the working group meetings. Consequently the Postoperative Delirium and Cognitive Dysfunction (PoDeCoD) Working group has ceased to exist and is now a part of DeLTO. A proposed recommendation on the terminology of delirium, encephalopathy and related terms will be discussed within the DeLTO working group.</p>	Ib Jammer
