Hemodynamics Pathway: The 3-step educational pathway was successfully completed, culminating in the Advanced Hemodynamics Course held during LIVES 2025. The initiative was well received and will continue to be refined for future editions.

Fellowship Programme: Led by Oliver Hunsiker, the fellowship has been successfully implemented with positive feedback from participants and mentors.

ELSO/ECLS Collaboration: Updates were presented by Daniel De Backer and Leem Vercamst, highlighting joint efforts and upcoming projects in extracorporeal support.

EDEC: Martin Balik presented current status of EDEC. Large number of candidates. Current discussions underway regarding future organization + execution of the program.

Webinars: Ahmed Zaher reported strong engagement across the webinar series.

Podcasts: Also coordinated by Ahmed Zaher, the podcast series continues to expand its reach and will explore new hemodynamic and diagnostic themes in 2026.

- OSS Study: Xavier Monnet reported that the Observational Shock Study continues to enrol centers.
- SICU-2: Michelle Chew provided an update on the ongoing study activities. Enrollment expected to close by end-2025.

- POP-OUT: Arne Feldheiser was not in attendance.
- Future Studies: Potential new multicenter projects were discussed, including collaborations under evaluation.
