Education

On February 8, 2018, a Webinar on **Damage control resuscitation in trauma patients**, presented by Sophie Hamada and moderated by Luke Leenen, has taken place. Attendance has been good (about 30 participants).

The learning module on **Multiple Trauma** has been updated and included in the ESICM new e-learning platform. The material has been produced by a wide writing group (<u>listed at the end of this document</u>) and reviewed by Sophie Hamada, Luke Leenen, and Kjetil Sunde. We thank all the contributors for their excellent work!

On 27-28/11/2018 an **ESICM Masterclass** on Trauma entitled "**The Art of Trauma Care**" chaired by Jacques Duranteau and endorsed by the TEM Section (which has participated in building both the programme and the Faculty) will take place at the ESICM Training Centre in Brussels. The event is already fully booked and a second edition has been scheduled for November 2019.

ESICM LIVES Congress 2018

Presentations

As for the previous Congress in Vienna, TEM has been assigned a total of 16 sessions for the Paris 2018 Congress:

- 3 Thematic sessions
 - Advanced Life Support in cardiac arrest
 - Burns and Toxicology
 - Initial trauma care
 - 2 State-of-the-art sessions
 - Joint with ERC: Cardiac arrest management
 - Joint with ESA: Hot topics in trauma management
- 2 Clinical challenges sessions
 - ECMO for cardiac Arrest
 - Post-resuscitation care
- 1 live interactive debate
 - Prognostication after cardiac arrest

Abstract sessions

A total of 111 abstracts pertaining TEM has been accepted for the Paris Congress. This represents a 37% increase as compared with the previous Congress, when 81 abstracts were accepted. The abstract score

this year has increased from 3.12 to 3.23, including the abstracts which were rejected. Ten abstracts has been presented in oral sessions, 10 discussed in the Arena, while the remaining were presented in poster sessions.

Ongoing/upcoming studies of interest

We had an update on status of the ongoing TTM 2 and TAME trials. Both studies have started to enroll patients.

ESICM LIVES Congress 2019

The next ESICM LIVES Congress will take place from 28 September to 2 October 2019 at the Berlin CityCube, in Berlin, Germany. First drafts of the programme will be discussed at the Congress Committee meetings this fall. All the participants were invited to send proposal to Kjetil Sunde and Claudio Sandroni within the next two weeks.

Other events (not ESICM-endorsed)

A Symposium on Cardiac Arrest will be held in Rome from 16 to 19 December, 2018. The event is not endorsed by ESICM, but the Faculty will include TEM members and the topic is relevant to the Section.
