I was the Counselor of the French Minister of Health for Research and Medical Education from 2012 to 2017, the Vice-Chancellor of university of Versailles from 2004 to 2007, and the President of the French Society of Intensive Care Medicine in 2011-2012.

I am an editor of the Cochrane Collaboration since 2000, and was the chair of the European Society of Intensive Care Medicine Systematic Review Group from 2010 to 2013.

I have contributed to several international and multi-disciplinary guidelines.

I authored about 450 peer –reviewed articles (H-index 81; citations 54923, Google scholar), and about 150 book chapters.

I have mentored several young colleagues since 1996, some of them being now faculty members in French Universities.
