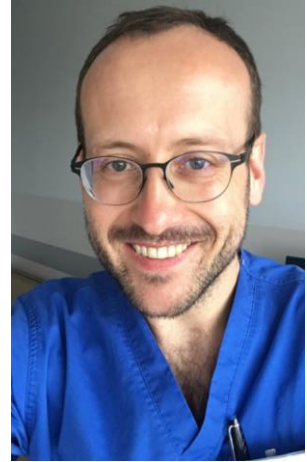

Currently, I am proud to be the youngest full professor and Head of University Department of Anaesthesiology and Intensive Care in Poland.
