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Successes

- The Data Science section has grown
 - >100 voting members, about 400 total members
- Data science courses flourish
 - Pre-congress face to face course
 - Digital ESICM Academy Critical Care Education course
- Data sharing is gaining momentum in Europe
 - AmsterdamUMCdb, HiRID, SICdb
- Consortium for federated data sharing
 - Applied for EU funding

Successes

- Reviews on applications of machine learning are out
 - Machine learning for the prediction of sepsis
 - Artificial Intelligence in intensive care medicine: ready for lift-off?
 - Reinforcement learning: outcomes and level-of-readiness
- Datathons are ever popular
 - Online format over the course of one month
 - Many new professional connections
 - 4+ peer reviewed publications, many abstracts

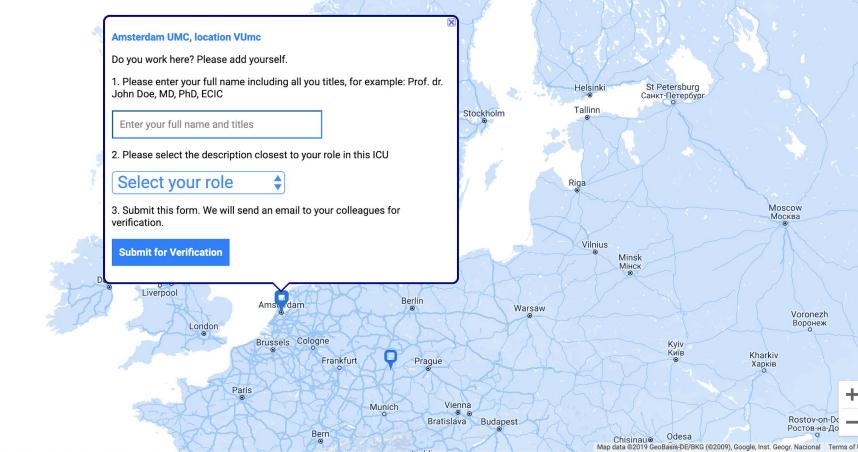
