Please note that my application is focussed specifically on the creation of a "Patient/Family expert group" for the ESICM as discussed with Pr Elie Azoulay. I'm afraid I would not have time to perform other jobs/activities in the Committee.

I am a sociologist. I obtained my PhD in Sociology in 2005 (end-of-life decision-making in the ICU and the experience of family members and clinicians). After teaching sociology for 2 years at the University of Bordeaux (France), I joined the Famiréa research group

directed by Pr Elie Azoulay at the Hôpital Saint Louis in Paris. Within this multidisciplinary group, of which I am now the co-director, I have developed mixed methodology approaches, including a qualitative approach to issues such as the end of life, bereavement and organ donation. I am the principal investigator of several Randomized Controlled Trials on the impact of communication strategies to alleviate burden in bereaved relatives.

Through qualitative research, my regular contacts with family members, as an outsider to ICU care, gives me a rich and original approach to their experience. In France, within the Famiréa group, we are currently setting up a group of French “family experts”. This experience could be beneficial to the ESICM in its aim to create a group of expert families on a European level. I would be happy to participate in this initiative and share my experience in creating such a group in France.
