



JEAN-LOUIS TEBOUL

The European Society of Intensive Care Medicine (ESICM) is honoured to award this medal to Professor Jean-Louis Teboul in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the field of intensive care medicine. Prof. Teboul's exemplary career spans over four decades, marked by his dedication to clinical excellence, groundbreaking research, and unparalleled commitment to education and mentorship.

Prof. Teboul received his medical degree from the University Paris V and specialised in internal medicine, cardiology, and intensive care. In 1995, he earned a PhD in cardiorespiratory physiology and pathophysiology from the University Paris V. He has been part of INSERM UMR_S 999 "Hypertension pulmonaire: Physiopathologie et Innovation Thérapeutique," under the direction of Prof. Marc Humbert.

He has held prestigious positions at Henri Mondor Hospital, Bicêtre Hospital, and Paris-Saclay University, where he served as Professor of Therapeutics and Intensive Care Medicine. His leadership as the Head of the Medical ICU at Bicêtre Hospital significantly advanced patient care and clinical practices. This school of excellence continues to thrive, maintaining its high level of impact, excellence, and innovation.

An esteemed researcher, Prof. Teboul's work on cardiopulmonary interactions, cardiovascular monitoring, and fluid responsiveness has profoundly influenced critical care protocols globally. His innovative approaches, such as the development of pulse pressure variation (PPV) and passive leg raising (PLR) tests, have become standard practices in the assessment and management of critically ill patients. Prof. Teboul has been instrumental in creating a school of critical care with a strong focus on hemodynamic monitoring. Numerous young clinicians and researchers from France and around the world, mentored by him and his own mentees, have spread excellence and improved patient care globally.

Prof. Teboul has published over 350 articles in peer-reviewed journals, contributed 160 book chapters, and delivered more than 1,250 invited lectures worldwide. His editorial roles, including Editor-in-Chief of the Annals of Intensive Care and Journal of Intensive Medicine, further demonstrate his influence on the field's scholarly landscape.

His extensive service to ESICM includes his role as Chair of the Cardiovascular Dynamics section, French representative, Treasurer, and Chair of the Congress Committee and underscores his dedication to advancing intensive care medicine on a global scale. Prof. Teboul's accolades, such as the Honorary Fellow of the American College of Chest Physicians and the International Honorary Membership of the Indian Society of Critical Care Medicine, are a testament to his international impact.

In recognition of his extraordinary achievements, his strong commitment to patient care, and his pioneering contributions to the field of intensive care medicine, ESICM proudly awards the 2024 medal to Professor Jean-Louis Teboul.
