current elected member of the N&AHP committee, I hold the foundational ICU expertise and existing ESICM engagement essential for this position.

My ICU-focused research and professional activity builds on my commitment to advancing intensive care practice. Currently, as Principal Investigator of the UK NIHR "FEARLESS" project (2023–2028), I am leading a comprehensive multi-method examination of collaborative working in intensive care units post–COVID–19, directly addressing workforce resilience and patient safety.
