I am Emanuele Rezoagli, Intensive Care Medicine Specialist, Assistant Professor of Anaesthesia and Critical Care at the University of Milano–Bicocca, and Consultant Anaesthetist and Intensivist at Fondazione IRCCS San Gerardo dei Tintori in Monza. I am honored to apply for the position of Italian National Representative within the European Society of Intensive Care Medicine (ESICM).

After graduating and completing my residency in Anesthesia and Intensive Care, I developed a career at the intersection of clinical care, translational research, and teaching. Since joining ESICM in 2017, I have been an active member of the Acute Respiratory Failure Section and contributed to the Translational Biology Group Section, helping shape initiatives during and after the COVID–19 pandemic.

My research activity focuses on respiratory pathophysiology, mechanical ventilation, and advanced monitoring in acute respiratory failure. I have authored over 150 peer-reviewed publications (h-index 33) and have been awarded several competitive grants, including the SIAARTI National Research Grant (15000 euro), the ESICM Young Investigator Award (2018), the Bicocca Starting Grant (2020), and the EU-funded TURISE Project (2025, Co-PI).

As an educator, I serve as Professor of Anaesthesia and Critical Care in the elective course

“Pathophysiology of Mechanical Ventilation” and teach core modules (Anesthesiology and Emergency) at the University of Milano–Bicocca, alongside extensive experience in residency and postgraduate training both in Italy and abroad. This sustained engagement demonstrates my commitment to teaching, mentoring, and promoting knowledge transfer.

If elected as National Representative, I envisage this function as an opportunity to:
Strengthen Inclusivity and Diversity – ensuring recognition of merit and equal opportunities across all career stages.

Represent Different Environments – voicing the needs of colleagues in both academic and non-academic ICUs.

My academic work focuses on respiratory pathophysiology and mechanical ventilation, with particular emphasis on acute respiratory failure, ARDS, ventilator management, and lung monitoring. I am the author of more than 150 peer-reviewed publications (h-index 33, source: Scopus) and have contributed to advancing both physiological and translational aspects of intensive care.

I have secured several competitive grants, including:
