## Details on your candidature

Prof. Egi is a distinguished leader with over 27 years of experience in clinical intensive care, academic research and education. He currently serves as Professor in the Department of Intensive Care and Anesthesia at Kyoto University and has made substantial contributions to the field both in Japan and globally.

He graduated from Okayama University in 1999. Following residency and trainee in anesthesiology and intensive care, he was clinical research fellow in department of intensive care, Austin hospital and worked with the late Professor Rinaldo Bellomo for over ten years. He received his undergraduate degree in Philosophy at Okayama University. His research focuses on the clinical epidemiology and outcomes of critical illness, especially in acute blood glucose control, body temperature control in critically illness, delirium, acute kidney injury and fluid management in acute ill patients. He has published about 160 peer review articles (H-index 43 at web of science May 15th 2025). He has served as principal investigator of Japan-Korea Intensive Care Study group (JAKOICS) and Asia critical care clinical trial group (ACCCTG).

He is the youngest Vice President in the history of JSICM, helping lead a truly multi-professional academic society with over 12,000 members, including physicians, nurses, physiotherapists, pharmacists, clinical engineers and other healthcare professionals. Prof. Egi has been instrumental in supporting young professionals. He supervises JSICM's U35 and U45 programs, which support early-career (under 35 years old) and mid-career (36-45 years old) multi-professional members. Under his leadership, these initiatives have become national models for multi-professional development.

He has played a central role in shaping JSICM Annual Meetings for over a decade. The 2025 annual meeting welcomed over 9,000 attendees, including overseas participants, reflecting his commitment to inclusive, forward-looking academic exchange.

Prof. Egi has also been a driving force in international collaboration. As a core member and longstanding leader of JSICM's International Communication for more than 15 years, he has played a pivotal role in building strong relationships with societies across the global critical care community.
